Maths

In Maths we will be continuing to learn about numbers up to 10. We will be developing our ability to subitise (say how many is in a group without counting each object) and using our knowledge of numbers to add and subtract in simple problems. We will be learning to use toolkit resources to help us solve problems and learning to justify and explain our thinking in mathematical problems. In our busy time we will be exploring capacity, 2D and 3D shapes (inc names and properties) as well as using measures in our activities.

Topic

This half term we will be linking lots of our learning to our themes: Super me, super you, super families! And then Christmas/Nativity. We will be thinking about what makes each of us special and unique and how we can celebrate this. We will be thinking about our own aspirations, learning about different jobs and roles as we grow up as well as discussing our families and the important people in our lives. We will be using key texts to support this learning - Supertato and A superhero like
