

Maths

This half term, pupils will learn how to divide by 7, 9, 11 and 12. The children will be multiplying and dividing by 0 and 1 as well as using formal methods to multiply and divide up to three digit numbers.

We will also be learning to draw and read pictograms, bar graphs and line graphs.

Science/Topic

Science: Animals including Humans- the digestion process, teeth and food chains including predators, producers and prey.

History/Geography: Vicious Vikings: We will be learning about where the Vikings came from as well as where they invaded and settled, with a particular focus on our local area.
