

Maths

This half term we will be focusing on **fractions** then **2-d shape**. We will be exploring equal groups, halves, quarters and thirds, finding part of a set or a quantity. We will then move onto counting in tenths, adding and subtracting, finding equivalent and simplest fractions and comparison. We will find lines of symmetry and study turning and moving shapes.

Science: In Science, we will be focusing on nutrition and healthy eating.

Topic: From Farm to Fork - the journey of our food. We will be planting and harvesting and exploring different types of soil and how to keep it healthy.
