**Sun Safety Policy** 

# **Christ Church Sun Safety Policy**

At Christ Church C of E Primary School we want staff and pupils to enjoy the sun safely. We will work with staff, pupils and parents to achieve this through:

### **EDUCATION**

- Talking about how to be SunSmart in assemblies at the start of the summer term.
- Sending parents and carers a letter explaining what the school is doing about sun protection and how they can help at the beginning of the summer term.

## **PROTECTION**

### Shade:

- Foundation Stage and Year 1 will erect canopies and sun shades in their outdoor area to provide shade on hot days when learning is outdoors.
- The playground has tree boarders which provide natural shade.
- We have purchased picnic tables and parasols to provide shade along the play areas at the front and back of the school.

### Clothing:

All children are encouraged to bring sun hats into school when the weather is hot.

### Sunscreen:

- We ask families to put sunscreen on their child before the start of the school day.
- Sunscreen use is encouraged on school trips and staff are provided with extra sunscreen in case children forget their own.
- Staff will support pupils in applying suncream during the summer months.

### Water:

- Children are encouraged to bring water bottles into school
- Water bottles are available to children throughout the day

### **TIMETABLING**

- Foundation Stage children will not be outside for periods of longer than half an hour at a time during very high temperatures
- During high temperatures, outdoor PE lessons will be taken during the second afternoon session and not directly after lunch playtime to avoid over exposure to high temperatures
