Maths

In Maths we will exploring numbers between 5 and 10 through play based activities. We will be thinking about problem solving strategies in practical activities and using our rapid recall of number facts to help us with these. We will be learning new number rhymes and songs as well as working on our number recognition.

Topic / theme

This half term we will be linking lots of our learning to our theme: 'Fishy Friends!' We will be using the books 'The Rainbow Fish' to inform our play and learning activities. We will be learning about what makes a good friend and how we can be one, understanding what sharing is, things that make us special and unique and learning all about different sea creatures.
