Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to provide you with a school update and let you know the class arrangements for next year. You will be receiving your child's school report on Friday 9th July and your child's class teacher will set aside some time to be available, should there be anything you need explaining further or wish to discuss. As they have only just moved in, the current Year 3 pupils will stay in their classrooms for Year 4 and teachers will move to join them. This means that Y6 pupils will move into the Annex building. Teachers are legally entitled to Planning, Preparation and Assessment time each week to ensure high quality teaching and learning for pupils. We cover this time by employing staff to work with children on specialist areas. At the end of this term, we will be saying goodbye to Mrs Milward who has provided PPA cover for our pupils and is now taking early retirement. We wish Mrs Milward every future happiness and thank her for how supportive she has been to our school – especially during the many changes of lockdown. We are currently recruiting an Art specialist to provide PPA cover alongside Mr Longstaffe who will be delivering computing and music across the school. These are exciting appointments for our children as they will strengthen our learning opportunities and we will tell you more about how this works in our curriculum at the start of the Autumn term.

Summer Club

Over the Summer Holidays we will be running 3 weeks of childcare and education activities; they will have a weekly theme and children will explore reading, writing and maths activities during the morning to keep their knowledge going over the long summer break as well as sport, art and outdoor activities in the afternoons. The aim is to have fun, socialise and learn in a relaxed, fun environment different to the normal school day. Families can provide packed lunches or opt into our delicious menus and drinks and snacks will be provided. The sessions run from 9am to 4pm and will be located in the canteen building at the top of the driveway. Look out for the leaflet and booking form to secure your place; we are delighted that we have been successful in receiving funding for Free School Meal pupils and can offer paid for places to those families who would like to purchase sessions.

Building Works

We have just found out that we have also been successful in our building bids and have secured a huge amount of funds to replace our old heating and radiator systems throughout the school as well as all flat roofs and the main pitched roof. This will make a great improvement to the environment for our pupils and future proof our school building for years to come. We are also continuing with our pupil toilet refurbishments over the break and are working towards turning one of our outbuildings into an art studio – so a very busy holiday at Christ Church and lots to look forward to next year!
