Maths

In Maths we will be learning about numbers 1 to 3. We will be going in depth with these to ensure children know and remember ways to make these numbers, recognise these quantities in different patterns and representations without counting (subitising), learning about 1 more than different numbers and shapes using these numbers. For children that have been with us last year or that demonstrate the knowledge and skills to extend their learning, we will be following their interests to plan real life contexts where they need to use and apply their knowledge of these numbers to solve practical problems.

Topic

We will be using the stories Happy to be me and The Little Red Hen to inspire our learning. Keep an eye out on Twitter to see some of the fun we get up to linked to this topic! We will be learning about ourselves, our families and how these can be similar/different. Phonics / English

In Phonics we will be learning to hear and say sounds in words, notice the initial sound in words and talk about different sounds we can hear. We will be playing games to help us orally blend and segment words (break them up into the sounds within and vice versa to say a whole word. For children that have been with us last year or that demonstrate the knowledge and skills to extend their learning, we will be encouraging them to independently break up a word into the sounds as well as blend longer words, we will be providing opportunities for them to recognise print and begin to notice letters in words. We will be focusing on a nursery rhyme each week, thinking about the vocabulary involved and learning the meaning of any unfamiliar words as well as rehearsing and performing the ones we learn.

RE & Worship

In RE we will be learning about how we are all special. Our RE curriculum allows us to teach this linked to Christianity as well as other faiths such as Islam, this si done in an age appropriate way and allows children to learn and explore their own thoughts and ideas. We will also be sharing in regular worship together where we sing together and join members of our community such as Christ Church Clergy.

Home School Partnership
