

## Maths

In Maths we will be learning how to 'subitise'. We will be using our 'fast eyes' and thinking quick to help us say a quantity up to 5 without counting individual items. We will be encouraging the children to talk about what they see in an arrangement of objects e.g. I can see 3 and 1 that's 4. We will be using our play resources to explore representing different numbers, shape and measures.

## Topic

We will be using the stories A superhero like you, When I grow up, Superkid and The Little Red Hen to inspire our learning. ## English

In English we will be linking lots of our learning to our theme 'Marvellous me and my super celebrations!'. Within this we will learn about People who help us as well as Harvest time.
