Place Value: count in multiples of 25, 100 and 1000, number sequences within 10 000, place value to 4 digits (th/h/t/o), compare numbers using language such as 'greater', 'smaller', 'less' and 'more', using the mathematical symbols <, > and =, rounding numbers to the nearest 1000, 100 and 10

Addition and subtraction: column and mental methods to add and subtract with numbers up to 10 000,

Science/Humanities

Science: States of Matter- solids, liquids and gases.

History: Radical Romans: *How did the Romans make a difference to our lives now?*
