Look what we have enjoyed this week...

Pre-school have really enjoyed rehearsing our songs for the nativity this week! They have also had lots of fun continuing with our Christmas activities.

FS2 have really enjoyed becoming artists this week. They learnt about Monet and his pointillism technique before copying some of his artwork to practise different skills and then using them to create their own Monet inspired picture of Bethlehem. The EYFS team are super proud of all of our amazing children for their super effort in our Nativity performance- singing loud and sharing the story of Jesus' birth with our families was the highlight of our week.

Year 1 enjoyed sharing their nativity with their grown ups this week. They have worked so hard on learning our words and our songs!

Year 2 have had a busy week. They have performed their Magical Christmas Journey and also started their DT unit of work; learning about sewing skills and designing and making their own puppets!

Year 3 have been continuing to learn about multiplication and how to solve problems using the column method. In English they have been up-levelling their sentences using adverbs, imperative verbs and subordinate clauses. They have also been rehearsing for the Christmas Service in Church and they can't wait to show you all of their learning this half term!

Year 4 geographers have learned about the human and physical changes from when the Romans invaded Britain. They were puzzled as to why they brought over stinging nettles, until they learned that the Romans used the sting to keep warm in a colder climate! They also had lots of fun working on our hockey skills.

Year 5 had a very busy but fantastic week in Year 5 this week! They have been rehearsing for the Value Assembly on Thursday and also practising songs and words for our Christmas Service next week! As well as that, they have also been practising map drawing skills and learning to use an atlas to find specific places in the UK and Europe that were most impacted by the Bubonic Plague in Medieval Times. They have also been investigating which materials are conductors and which are insulators in Science.

Year 6 enjoyed their visit to Port Sunlight. They used their map reading skills to navigate to different features around the village. The visit concluded with watching a pantomime at the Gladstone Theatre.

Nurture class have had lots of fun making Christmas crafts this week. They have also enjoyed their nativity performances this week!


