Pre-school have enjoyed working on their 'thankfulness tree', sticking all the things we are thankful for onto a tree in the classroom. They also spent time designing pancakes with different toppings!

FS2 have enjoyed learning all about Shrove Tuesday this week. They learnt about being shroven and how cupboards are usually emptied before Lent. They made playdough pancakes and tried to flip them, described yummy pancakes in their writing groups, practised their cutting skills by filling pancakes with tasty toppings and even made pancake shops for their friends to buy treats. Year 5 have had a fabulous end of the half term. They have continued practising their sketching and shading skills, drawing Tudor portraits. Year 6 have worked with great focus in English this week to complete their newspaper reports. In Science, they have been researching the different parts of the eye and the functions of each of these. 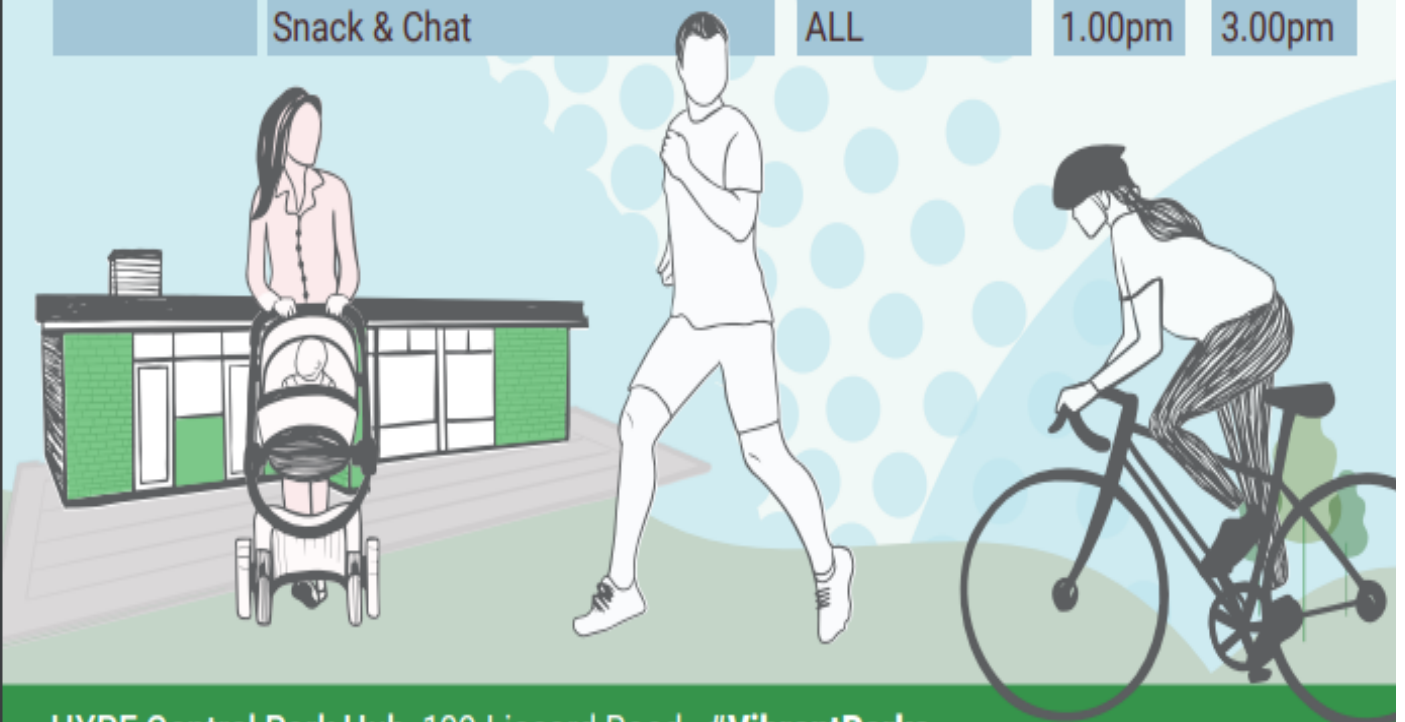
