Look what we have enjoyed this week...

Pre-school have been looking at a new story called "The Naughty Bus". The preschool children created a story map and have enjoyed doing activities linked to our book!

FS2 Lots of imagination and collaboration in the home corner this morning. F2 are cooking, ironing, watching twand making phone calls. What a creative bunch!

Year I have had a brilliant first week back at school. We've started exploring our new book - The lighthouse keepers lunch. In maths, we have started looking at division and sharing amounts out. We are looking forward to exploring 'how do we keep safe at sea?' in history and geography. We used our checking glasses to purple polish our work!

Year 2 have been learning all about Amy Johnson and her solo journey to Australia in 1930. We were then amazed to learn that just 40 years later man walked on the moon! 'One small step for man, one giant leap for mankind'!

Year 3 have started their new key text this week: 'Charlotte's Web'. They have been using their inference skills to deduce what Fern is like as a main character. In Maths they have been learning about the 24- hour and the 12-hour clock and how time can be represented. SCODE has been about super suffixes and the changes that can be made to a root word.

Year 4 have began the summer term with a bang! Quite literally- we have explored what happens when we banged tuning forks and observed the vibrations in water and sugar; we loved watching rice grains dance on drum skins!

Year 5 have enjoyed welcoming back our Year Five children this week. We have started to practise our athletics skills in readiness for sports day, we are conquering our decimals in maths and have drafted creative poems in English.

Year 6 have settled back to their work really well and they seem as eager as ever in all lessons. In English, they have continued to read Letters from the Lighthouse and are writing a first person account of a key event in the story. In maths, they have successfully completed a variety of challenging problems involving ratio and fraction equivalences. During this week's science lesson, the children have explored how periscopes work and have even constructed their own.


