If children display the following: symptoms:



- * a new, cotinuous cough
- * high temperature of 37.8°
- * loss of taste or smell
- * other symptoms in line with recent reported cases

School will:

- Ask parents to collect children and advise that they go for a PCR test 1.
- Ask child to remain at home until their test results arrive 2.



If negative - pupils can return to school



If positive result - pupil must remain at home for 10 days and access home learning
