

What should you do if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19?

To reassure our families, we wanted to update you on our position in response to increasing Wirral positive COVID19 cases:

School is ...



Providing additional cleaning

Following catch it, bin it, kill it advice



Operating in year groups outdoors and distancing classes indoors



Initiating seating plans to reduce potential transmission



Asking all adults to please support the wearing of face coverings

Offering remote learning as an option for siblings of positive cases



If children display the following symptoms:



- * a new, continuous cough
- * high temperature of 37.8°
- * loss of taste or smell
- * other symptoms in line with recent reported cases

School will:

1. Ask parents to collect children and advise that they go for a PCR test
2. Ask child to remain at home until their test results arrive

If negative - pupils can return to school

If positive result - pupil must remain at home for 10 days and access home learning
