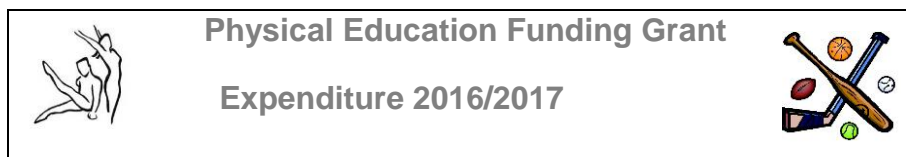

Measuring Impact of PE fund spending

Teachers will be asked to meet with coaches prior to block sessions to discuss their development needs and the needs of their class. Evaluations will be completed each term.

Lesson observations will evidence good or better teaching and learning and progression of skills over the lesson.

Pupil progress will be evaluated by the PE leader and impact measured.

Pupil surveys will be completed.

Records kept of attendance at clubs and participation in competitions and tournaments.

Outcomes Report October 2017

Specialist Sports Coaches - Claremount Sports College provided high quality CPD opportunities for all KS2 staff. This linked in with school's long term map and progression of skills. KS1 staff received CPD through a different company which was found to not be as effective and as beneficial as that received in KS2. This led to the employment of school's sports coach summer 2017 who would teach PE across the school with CPD being delivered across the school by Claremount for 2017/18.

Release time for PE lead has enabled her to become skilled in how to use iDoeco for assessment in PE and plan staff meeting linked to this. She has attended a level 1 yoga course that will be used in weekly teaching linked to the school's drive on well-being. Completed application to retain bronze sports award, planned new look sports day at Claremount Sports College alongside colleagues there. Distributed information and attended tournaments, (netball, football, tag rugby and tri golf) games (football) and enrichment activities (Skating and skateboarding) for children to take part in across the school. Liaised with new school's sports coach to ensure that policies are followed and lessons across the school follow long term map and progression of skills.

PE Apprentice worked effectively in supporting teachers in lessons, also communication with parents. She also took on the responsibility of uploading PE documents for parents on to eschools and also in enrichment activities such as in line skating, as well as supporting swimming and sports day.

PE ipad has enabled a consistent approach to PE assessment in line with NC, Wirral Scheme, school's long term map and skills of progression. All teaching staff have accessed training linked to how to use this to assess and monitor pupil progress and attainment.
