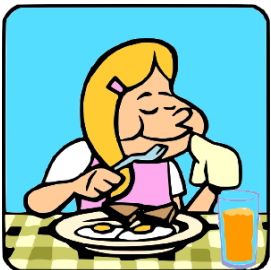
Re: Free School Meals/Milk
& Universal Infant School Meals
(free of charge) for FS2, Y1 and Y2 children



Even though from September 2014 all children in FS2, Y1 and Y2 will be entitled to a Universal Infant School Meal free of charge, **it is imperative that if you think you are entitled to Free School Meals under the states benefit's scheme as shown on this leaflet you must still apply for them.**



The important reason for this is that when you claim Free School Meals it entitles schools to have extra Government Funding put in to its budget. This is called Pupil Premium and is used to support children's needs within school.



Children are entitled to free school meals and milk if you or your, partner are receiving:

1. Income Support **OR**
2. Income based Jobseekers Allowance **OR**
3. Income related Employment & Support Allowance **OR**
4. Guaranteed Pension Credit **OR**
5. Child Tax Credit with a total taxable income of less than £16,190 but **NOT** receiving Working Tax Credit.

You must provide proof of any state benefit mentioned above.

If you feel you may be entitled to claim free meals and milk, you can do this by either:

Calling in at the 'One Stop Shop', Knutsford Road, Moreton, CH46 8TN, and filling in an Application Form, or

Ringling tel. No. 606 2002 and asking for an Application Form to be sent to you.

Please do apply early as the Local Authority is usually inundated with claims in the September of each year.

Please note that free milk is served with lunchtime meals, therefore milk that is given at morning play must be paid for.
