Maths

In maths, children will be further enhance their understanding of fractions and decimals through:

- comparing and ordering fractions,
- recognising mixed numbers and improper fractions and converting from one to the other.
- read and write decimals as fractions,
- round decimal numbers with two decimal places to the nearest whole number and to one decimal place,
- read, write, order and compare numbers with up to 3 decimal places.

Science/History/Geography

Science:

- Living things and their habitats.

History:

- Research largest natural disasters in world history and how these have affected civilisation
- Compare and contrast two natural disasters

Geography:

- Explore different biomes.
- Research into climate change and how it is affecting the Earth
- Analyse the similarities and differences between North America and the UK.
