<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Year groups to remain separated for all activities</li> <li>• Classes in year group to be separated whilst indoors and only mixing outdoors</li> <li>• Continue with catch it, bin it, kill it approach and continuous ventilation</li> <li>• Continue to clean down tables and equipment between use</li> <li>• All school staff to wear masks in communal areas &amp; for meetings</li> <li>• Close contacts of positive cases can attend school if completing daily LFTs; if this isn't possible remote learning can be offered</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Parents to be requested and encouraged to wear masks</li> <li>• All visitors to school required to wear a mask or no admittance</li> <li>• Parents can access school building if wearing a mask and socially distanced for activities &amp; meetings</li> <li>• Positive cases can leave isolation on day 8 if negative LFTs on both day 6 &amp; 7</li> <li>• Isolation remains 10 days if still positive or no LFT available</li> </ul>

<p>F2 – Will work as a year group bubble across the area and outdoors. Close contact work will be completed in small groups with records of participants kept. Increased handwashing between practical and play activities</p> <p>Y1 - Will work in classes wherever possible when indoors and as a year group in the outdoor area. Group work can happen with pupils from each class in middle area, records of participants and seating plans must be kept daily. Increased handwashing between practical and play activities</p> <p>Y2 – Use Y2 toilets during lessons and Y3 for additional handwashing rotas Group work can happen with pupils from each class bubble in middle area, records of participants and seating plans must be kept daily</p> <p>Y3 - Will remain in their own classrooms with tables for middle area interventions separated into classes, records of participants and seating plans must be kept daily</p> <p>Y4 – Will continue in classrooms with pupils from one class at a time in intervention room, records of participants and seating plans must be kept daily, intervention area to be cleaned down between use</p> <p>Y5 – Will continue in classrooms and library, records of groups and seating plans must be kept daily, library area to be cleaned down between use</p>	<p>Staff meetings to be socially distanced and staff to wear masks PPA must be socially distanced Staff to be encouraged to eat in classrooms whenever possible / maximum of 6 staff in staffroom All staff to wear face coverings in communal areas Office areas accessed from glass door or corridor, if confidential arrange to meet safely in larger spaces Offices to comply with maximum room occupancy – 4 persons Staff to maintain social distancing as much as possible as often as possible Staff to wear gloves &amp; aprons when 2m isn't possible or handling multiple items Middy high touch area cleaning reinstated Continue to ventilate all rooms and remind families that children may wear warm under-layers beneath uniform Teaching staff to produce seating plan for lunchtimes to avoid extensive mixing</p>	



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Y6 - Will use classrooms and intervention room with pupils from each class, records of participants and seating plans must be kept daily and intervention room cleaned between use. Children from class 13 not to walk through class 14 to get to toilets / interventions room, must go around and vice versa.

**ANYONE with a new or persistent cough, temperature or change in taste / smell MUST be isolated and seek a PCR test.**

**Staff & pupils must continue to:**

- wash hands upon arrival and departure, after breaks and before lunch, between activities if pupils are handling multiple items (i.e. F2/Y1 resources)
- wipe down equipment between multiple use or set aside
- maintain enhanced cleaning of high touch areas
- maintain distance from others and not be in confined spaces - cupboards, car sharing etc
- continue to test twice weekly
- ventilate rooms well and work outdoors regularly to set rooms aside
- wear PPE for close contact activities and first aid etc
- promote catch it, bin it, kill it approach to hygiene and provide pupils with individual regularly used items

*As the weather gets colder pupils may wear leggings / skins underneath uniform as doors and windows will remain open for maximum ventilation*

Cover staffing will be arranged whenever possible; closure of classes for remote learning will be a last resort based upon number of cases and effective staffing numbers to be safe

**Arrangements for Activities**

**LUNCHES – all children to remain with own class during lunch at designated seating areas with all windows and doors open**

The hall will be used for F2 lunches with class bubbles sat together at designated tables. Y1 will continue to eat in the classroom and have food delivered to them; Y2 will access the hall once one year group has finished and tables have been cleaned down thoroughly  
 Y3 & Y5 will continue to eat in their classroom and have food delivered to them; Y4 & Y6 in canteen – staggered times & classes within year groups to have allocated tables and seating plan

**Outdoor playtimes** in year groups with allocated areas / activities. Equipment continued to be cleaned between use

**Clubs** in classes / clubs in year groups only if outdoors or spacing can be maintained. Register taken.

**Trips and Visits** to other venues can continue within class bubbles  
**Visitors to school** to be remote wherever possible and if on site only with masks and effective distancing

**PE & Team sports** in year groups only if outdoors

**CC4C** to operate in 2 groups with protective measures & daily register  
**Assemblies** in single year groups with children sitting in classes, 2m gap between classes and all doors open.

**Singing** to be socially distanced in the hall or as larger groups outdoors

**PPA Cover and Specialist teachers** will work with one class for half a day and rotate classes in the year groups to reduce mixing across school and minimise potential transmission
