#### Maths

This half term, pupils will continue to work on their multiplication and division. Children will learn how to multiply by 0 and 1. Children will learn how to multiply and divide using formal written methods, using their knowledge of multiplication tables to help them.

Children will continue to learn how to understand and solve word problems.

#### Science/Topic

<u>Science</u>: Animals including Humans- the digestion process, teeth and food chains including predators, producers and prey. Sound: How sounds are made. Understanding vibrations and looking at the 'pitch' of a sound.

<u>Topic</u>: Vicious Vikings: Where do the Vikings fit on a timeline of recent historical events? Where did the Vikings come from? Where did they invade/settle? What can place names tell us about Viking settlement? How and where did the Vikings trade? What did the Vikings value? What was everyday life like in Viking Britain? What tools/weapons were used?
