We are hoping that by September, school life will be back to normal and we can admit children in their year groups. However, as life has been so uncertain for such a long time, we have altered our induction plan so that we adhere to the current guidance for social distancing and this can continue whatever the stage of pandemic, as long as schools can open safely.

The plan enables smaller groups to start school together and we felt this would also support children who may have been at home for very long periods with little contact with their friends or access to pre-school provision. It will give us an opportunity to support any anxieties in small groups where we can give extra attention to individual children, whilst also maintaining all of our Health and Safety advice should this region still be struggling with Coronavirus.
