

Maths

Numbers to 10 000 : Count in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 25, 100, 1000; find 1000 more or less; order and compare numbers beyond 1,000; round to nearest 10, 100, 1000; using place value and making number patterns

Addition and Subtraction within 10 000:

Adding & subtracting using mental strategies, finding differences, formal methods of addition and subtraction, solving word problems

Science/Topic

Science: States of Matter- solids, liquids and gases; heating and cooling; reversible/irreversible changes; the water cycle

Topic: Ancient Rome - timeline and ordering of chronological events, sources and artefacts as well as study of democracy, the ancient roman empire, how the ancient romans lived and famous battles.
