

Look What We've Been Doing...

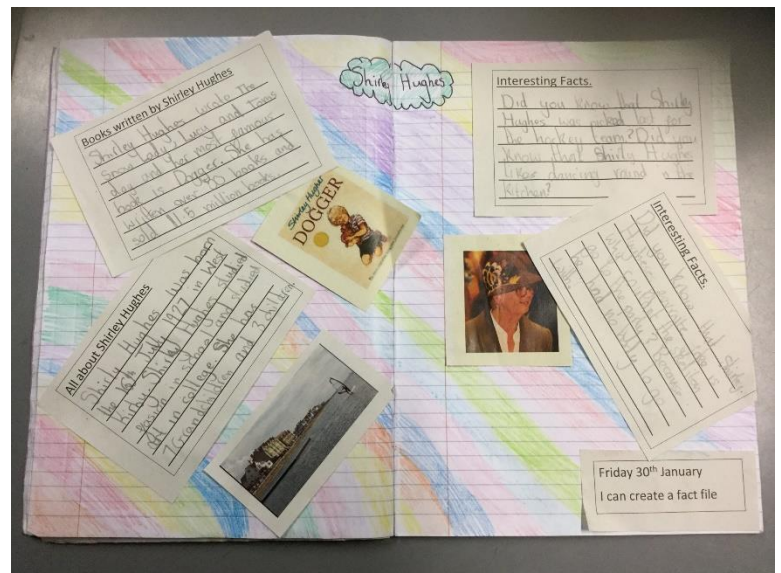


... in Year 2 this last half term (Spring Term 1)

What a busy start to 2020 it has been in Year 2!

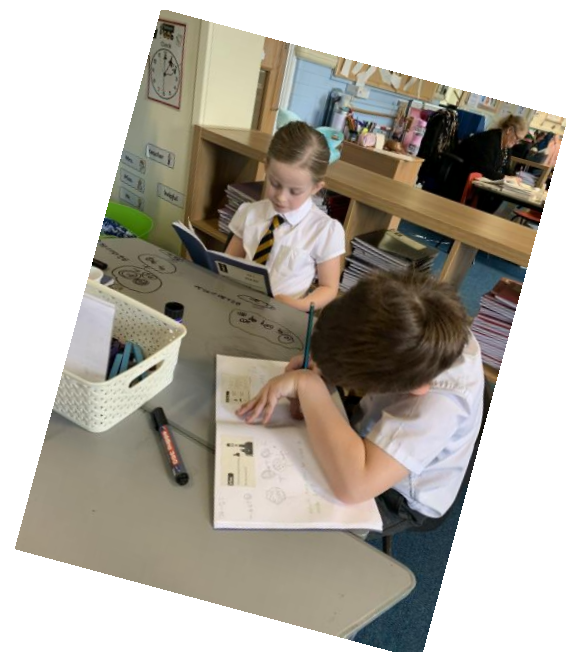
