
Morning drop off

Please ensure that you are remembering to follow the allocated times for **drop off** in the morning. Here they are again for your convenience:

FS2	9am (via grey gate and in through F2 doors)
Year 1	8.50am (via grey gate and in through Y1 doors)
Year 2	8.50am (via front green gate and through Y2 corridor)
Year 3	9am (via key pad gate and in through hall doors)
Year 4	9am (via front green gate and in through annex)
Year 5	8.45am (via grey gate and in through Y5 doors)
Year 6	8.45am (via front green gate and in through new Y6 doors)

Face coverings

Wearing masks or a **face covering is required** to be worn to cover the mouth & nose whilst dropping off and picking up your children, including CC4C. Please can you ensure that your face covering remains on your face at all times whilst on the school grounds and that you keep it on when talking to teachers or other school staff.
