Maths

During maths this half term we will begin to look at fractions. This will involve your child having the ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions and mixed fractions.

Following on from this, your child will learn how to find fractions of amounts, percentages of amounts, as well as the equivalences between fractions, decimals and percentages.

Science and computing

Based on the thorough research conducted by your child into classification, they will be developing their video editing skills to produce a David Attenborough style documentary.

Also, during computing the child will have the opportunity to use VR and AR to investigate habitats and animal's genera.

PE and Well Being

Children will take part in a weekly 2 hour PE session. Miss Cooper will lead the netball sessions in school and Mr Donalen with lead the gymnastic sessions in the Parish centre.

Topic and Art

During term, Year 6 topic will focus on life in Victorian Times in Port Sunlight. This will include life of a factory worker drawing comparisons on life today and the significance of Port Sunlight in the late 19th and 20th century.

During art sessions, the children will look at the work of William Morris and produce art work inspired by him.

DT will involve researching, designing and making Victorian Christmas Cake.

RE & Worship

The main R.E. theme for our lessons Incarnation : How do different artists show what is important about the Incarnation? How do different global communities show what is important about the Incarnation?
