## Teacher & TA audit will be undertaken in Autumn term and then repeated in June to measure the impact of CPD. Lesson observations will evidence good or better teaching and learning and progression of skills over the lesson, in addition to increased motivation and engagement from pupils. Assessment of PE using SAQs will measure progress from baseline - January - June Pupil surveys will be completed in the Autumn and in Summer to measure impact. Records kept of attendance at clubs and participation in competitions and tournaments will show more children accessing Application for Platinum Sports Award to be submitted Playtime monitoring to indicate more active involvement, cooperative play and fewer incidents of behaviour SENDCo to measure impact of OT and physio programmes Child & Family mentor to measure impact on mental health of those inactive children Christ Church will gather medals and trophies from competitions and tournaments. **Outcomes Report October 2021**
