Maths

In Maths we will be continuing to learn about numbers up to 5. We will be developing our ability to subitise (say how many is in a group without counting each object) and using our knowledge of numbers to add and subtract in simple problems. We will be focusing on deepening our knowledge of numbers so that we can rapidly recall number facts, apply this to solve problems and most importantly, talk about and explain our mathematical thinking.

Topic / theme

This half term we will be linking lots of our learning to our themes: Marvellous Me and my super celebrations! This will include learning about Christmas and the Nativity. We will be thinking about special events that we celebrate such as our birthdays, weddings and christenings. We will begin to think about how the very first Christmas was a special birthday and learn about how we can celebrate this by planning parties and baking cakes! We will be using key texts to support this learning - Cake!, Alfie and the birthday surprise and various Nativity themed books.
