Foundation Subjects

History and geography: children will continue to learn about Port Sunlight during the Victorian Times. They will understand what life was like in Port Sunlight in Victorian times, compared to other towns/cities. They will use maps to describe features and understand land use patterns in Port Sunlight and the importance of trade links. The unit will conclude with a visit to Port Sunlight. (Letters for this visit were distributed prior to half term).

Art: Children will research into the history of collage(decoupage) and investigate artists who have used collage in their work.

DT: Children will research and evaluate CAM mechanisms to use in their own circus inspired design.
