## Maths

This half term, the children will learn to add and subtract with numbers up to 10 000. They will use the column method for addition and subtraction and they will also learn mental methods for addition and subtraction. We will also learn how to multiply and divide by 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12. They will understand the difference between sharing and grouping and they will understand the commutative law in multiplication. They will also solve problems involving multiplication and division.
